The National Health Research Institutes (NHRI) is a non-profit and mission-oriented biomedical research institute in Taiwan. Its mission is to advance medical and health research and improve people's health and well-being. As one of NHRI's prestigious research units, the Immunology Research Center aims to study frontier translational research of immune-mediated diseases, explore the disease mechanisms of autoimmune disease and inflammatory diseases, and develop novel early diagnostic kits, immunotherapy, and therapeutic drugs.
